Dear Friend,

As we mark the summer solstice, and the Brandeis campus hums with the activity of summer programs for university and high school students, our thoughts turn to plans for the fall. In that spirit, we look forward to your continued participation in our High Holy Day community at Brandeis.

The 5771 High Holy Days begin in *early* September – right after Labor Day. Rosh Hashanah services will begin Wednesday evening, September 8, and continue Thursday, September 9, and Friday, September 10, 2010. Yom Kippur will commence Friday evening, September 17, and continue Saturday, September 18, 2010. The following services will be offered this year:

Reform: Led by Rabbi Albert S. Axelrad, Director Emeritus of Hillel at Brandeis, in Levin Ballroom, Usdan Student Center
Music Leaders: Sarah Kornfeld '03, Soprano, Boston Metro Opera and Benjamin Madsen, Tufts University

Conservative: Led by Rabbi Elyse Winick '86, Jewish Chaplain at Brandeis University, in Spingold Theater

Orthodox: Student led services with Rabbi Elliot Kaplowitz '02, Co-Director, Jewish Learning Initiative, Hillel at Brandeis, in the Berlin Chapel

Hillel at Brandeis is proud to have provided High Holy Day services for community members for more than four decades. Admission to our services is provided without fee for children 18 years of age and under, to Brandeis students, and all other university students. We seek a donation of \$300 per adult and ask those who are able to donate \$600 or more per person to do so.

Over the years, as you can well imagine, the costs for clergy and others involved in leading our services as well as expenses for set-up, rental of facilities, and campus security have increased dramatically. We encourage you to contribute in support of our High Holy Day community as generously as your circumstances will permit. Rest assured that no one will be turned away.

For security reasons, all congregants from off-campus must have tickets. Tickets will be sent to those who complete the enclosed Ticket Request Form. Those wishing to obtain tickets using their credit cards may call 781-736-3576. To receive your tickets by mail, Ticket Request Forms must be received by Thursday, August 26.
